

Saving bookmarks to a File for Loading on another Computer

1. Safari Directions:

Bookmarks>Show All Bookmarks>

While looking at all your bookmarks, highlight the whole left hand column - it will turn blue.

Go up to the top menu and File> Export This will place a file on your desktop.
Take the file on your flash drive or put it on the network.

Open up the Safari Browser on your new computer and go to Bookmarks>Show all
Then go up to file>import and select the file you created above .

2. FireFox Directions: Bookmarks>Organize Bookmarks>

Click on the top folder named bookmarks

Go to top menu and say File>Export File should be on desktop.

Import in a similar fashion on new machine.

3. There is another way I prefer to do this in Safari.

Go to your “little house” with your name on it in the finder window left hand sidebar.
Click on it and look through the list for Library. Open Library and find a folder named Safari. Copy that whole folder onto your flash drive. Take it to the new machine and replace the safari on that machine with the old safari folder.

Saving your mail and settings from MacMail to new MacMail

Go to your “little house”>Library>Mail
save this folder called Mail to your flash drive

Go to your “ little house”>Library>Preferences
click on the item called com.apple.mail.plist
Copy it to the flash drive.

On the new machine replace these items both with the ones you have on your flash drive.

(If you can't see the whole name of com.apple.mail.plist, click on the two little lines in the lower right hand corner of the window.)
